#### **Supplementary Notes**

The reporting entity is comprised of all organizations, committees and local boards accountable for the administration of their financial affairs and resources to the Township and which are owned or controlled by the Township. Interdepartmental and inter-organizational transactions and balances between these organizations are eliminated. These consolidated financial statements include the following joint local boards, which are not controlled by the Township, have been consolidated on a proportionate basis:
  - ▶ Perth and District Public Library Board
  - ▶ Drummond/North Elmsley Tay Valley Fire Rescue
- (2) The above data has been extracted from the audited 2015 Consolidated Financial Statements of the Township and its local boards as described in note 2.
