## MARKET ACCESS/HIGHWAYS

### Major Arterial Highways:

Highway 7 which runs east-west through the Township links to the 417 in the City of Ottawa which is 40 minutes away. The Township's close proximity to Highway 15, 10km puts us within one hour of Highway 401.

### County Roads:


County Road 29 links to Brockville in the south (60kms). Highway 43 leads to Perth to the west (12kms), and Kemptville (50km) to the southeast.

### Smiths Falls-Montague (Russ Beach) Airport (16km)

The airport is owned by the town of Smiths Falls and the Township of Montague but operated and maintained by volunteers from the Smiths Falls Flying Club. The aerodrome is registered (IATA: YSH, ICAO: CYSH) and airspace are not controlled, but published instrument approaches are available to both runway 06 (NDB) and 24 (GPS). There are private, commercial, military and emergency services activities at the airport.


