POSITION TITLE: CIVIL ENGINEERING TECHNICAL STUDENT

Full-Time 40hrs/wk. (7:00 a.m. – 3:30 p.m.)

Applicant will also be responsible for assisting with the collection and input of Asset Management data using various software programs.
