- Cereal and other food boxes, tissue boxes, shoe boxes
- Paper rolls from paper towel and toilet paper

CARDBOARD

- Corrugated boxes (Flattened and bundled)
 - Pizza boxes (Clean)



When the collection truck sees uncollectible material in your Yellow or Blue Box or Garbage, they will leave items behind with a tag explaining why.

Please remember

- 7am set-out on collection day
- NO recycling in plastic bags
- All recycling must be in a Blue or Yellow Box
- Containers must be rinsed clean for recycling; no food residue
- 2 Garbage bags per household per week without tags
- All other garbage bags require tags \$2 each (at Municipal Office & Landfill)
- Maximum garbage bag weight 40 lbs
- Garbage containers not to exceed 17 gallons
- No large item pick up, No leaf & yard waste pickup
