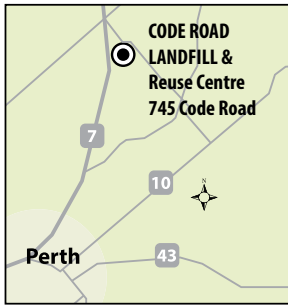


## Drummond/North Elmsley Township

 Saturdays 10 am - 1 pm (winter)  
 9 am - 3 pm (summer)

### Waste Diversion saves you Money

The following items diverted from landfill are accepted **FREE** of charge at the Code Road Landfill:



- Scrap metal, e-waste, tires, cardboard, brush, yard waste, and items for ReUse.

### Tipping fees are charged on garbage only:

\$75/metric tonne = Residential

\$125/metric tonne = Construction and demolition debris and all commercial garbage.

### Your Residential Waste Levy at Work:

\$190/year = \$3.95/week

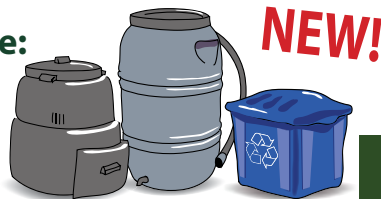
Waste Levy Per Household Per Week



- Waste Pick-up \$1/wk
- Blue Box Pick-up \$1.45/wk
- Landfill \$1.20/wk

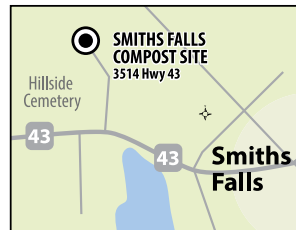

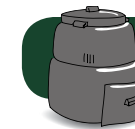
# WasteMatters 2018

'Tag & Leave' will continue in 2018.

**Blue Box**

When the collection truck sees uncollectible material in your blue box, they will leave items behind with a tag explaining why.

**2 Garbage bags per household per week without tags**

- All other garbage bags require tags - \$2 each at Municipal Office & Landfill
- Maximum bag weight 40 lbs.
- Garbage containers not to exceed 17 gallons.

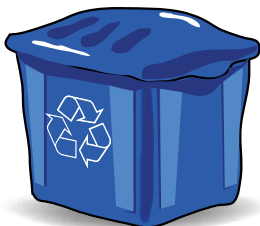

Electronics, Tires & Scrap Metal	<input type="checkbox"/>	Code Road Landfill
Household Hazardous Wastes (paint, oil, chemicals, batteries, etc)	<input type="checkbox"/>	Carlton Place Hazardous Waste Depot (SEASONAL)
Yard Waste (Grass, Leaves, Brush, etc)	<input type="checkbox"/>	Code Road Landfill
Over-sized Container exceeds 17 gallons	<input type="checkbox"/>	Glenview Iron & Metal Ltd. 613-283-5230 or Code Road Landfill
Container or Bag exceeds weight of 50 pounds	<input type="checkbox"/>	Code Road Landfill
Exceeds 2 Bag Limit, waste not tagged	<input type="checkbox"/>	Contact Township of Drummond/North Elmsley

## What's IN

Curbside Recycling Here's what goes in your Blue Box...



**PLASTIC**

- Containers with #1 - #7 (NOT #6 polystyrene)

**GLASS**

- Food and beverage jars ONLY (Return deposit containers to the Beer Store)

**METAL**

- Aluminum pop cans, steel food cans, aluminium foil and trays (clean)

**GABLE TOPS AND TETRA PAKS**

- Including milk, juice cartons, drinking boxes and spiral wound containers

**PAPER**

- Newspapers, magazines and telephone books, reading books (hard covers removed)
- Boxboard (from cereal and other food boxes, tissue boxes)
- Rolls from paper towels and toilet paper
- Cardboard (flattened and bundled)
- Pizza boxes (clean)

Thank you for recycling!

**WE CANNOT RECYCLE:**

- styrofoam
- film plastic (bags)
- non-container glass

## What's OUT

We cannot accept the following in your Blue Box...

- Styrofoam (#6 polystyrene)
- Film plastic/plastic bags
- Paper coffee cups
- Broken windows, light bulbs
- Clothes hangers, toys, flower pots,
- Non-food container metal, plastic or glass



**Please remember**

- 7am set-out on collection day.
- No material in plastic bags.
- All recycling must be in a Blue Box; no garbage cans, no oversized carts, no clear bags.
- Blue Box material must be rinsed clean; no food residue, no oil containers.



**Return deposit containers to the Beer Store**

If you put beer, wine, liquor bottles in your Blue Box, you're paying twice:

Deposit at Purchase + the Full Cost of Recycling

The township gets no funding for deposit containers, so you pay extra.

**Please RETURN deposit containers to the Beer Store Or DONATE to the Drummond Scouts at Code Road Landfill**
