Waste Diversion saves you Money

The following items diverted from landfill are accepted **FREE** of charge at the Code Road Landfill:



• Scrap metal, e-waste, tires, cardboard, brush, vard waste, and items for ReUse.

Tipping fees are charged on garbage only:

\$75/metric tonne = Residential \$125/metric tonne = Construction and demolition debris and all commercial garbage.

Your Residential Waste Levy at Work:





2 Garbage bags per household per week without tags





What's OUT


We cannot accept the following in your Blue Box...
